#### Neanderthals' Big Eyes

The Neanderthals are a now **3.0** *extinct* sub-group of the human species. They lived in Eurasia until approximately 40,000 years ago. From research, we have **3.1** \_\_\_\_\_ that they had larger eyes than humans have today. This probably helped them to see better, **3.2** \_\_\_\_\_ extra brain power. However, this may also have meant that they did not have enough brain power for using **3.3** \_\_\_\_\_ social skills. Neanderthals' brains were roughly the same size as modern humans', but may have been organized **3.5** \_\_\_\_\_. To investigate this, the skulls of 13 Neanderthals and 32 humans have been carefully **3.6** \_\_\_\_\_. Neanderthals had large bodies and larger eyes, needing larger visual systems in the brain.
